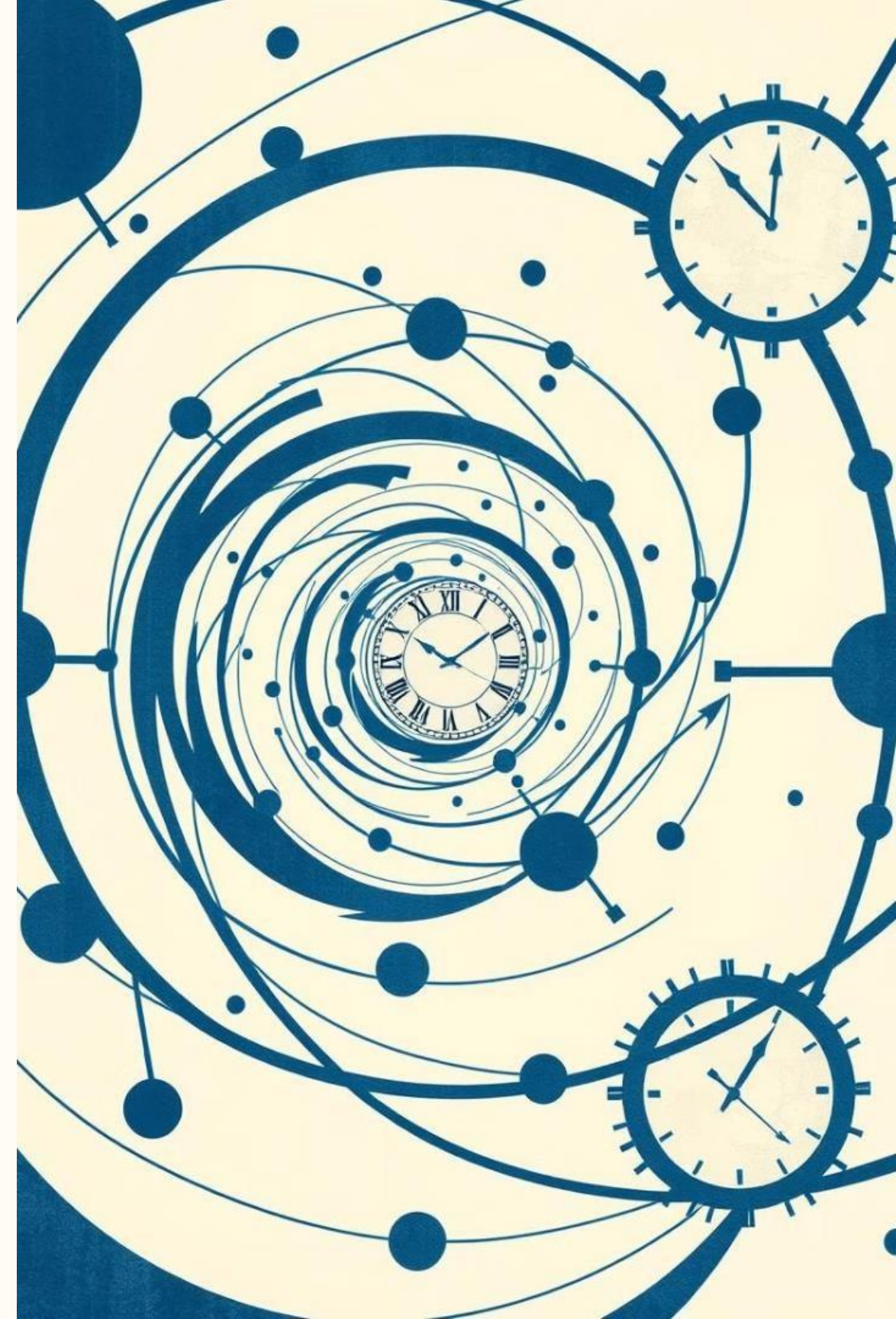

# Rumus dan Contoh

## Rumus

Positive: S +would +be +V-ing

Negative: S +would +not +be +V-ing

Interrogative: Would +S +be +V-ing?

## Contoh

+)I would be studying at 8 PM if you called me.

-) I would not be sleeping when you arrived.

Would you be playing soccer at 4 PM?

?)

# Penggunaan Past Future Continuous Tense

1 1.Menyatakan tindakan yang akan sedang berlangsung di masa depan dari perspektif masa lalu

He said he would be working at 9PM.

2 2. Membayangkan situasi yang tidak terjadi

I would be watching TV, but the electricity went out.

3 3. Menyatakan sopan permintaan, rencana, atau janji dari sudut pandang masa lalu

I thought you would be meeting us by now.





# Kata Keterangan Waktu

1

At 5 PM yesterday / last week, etc.

Contoh: At 5 PM yesterday, I would be working on my assignment.

2

By the time + time clause

Contoh: By the time you arrived, they would be discussing the report.

3

When + past action

Contoh: When I arrived, they would be having lunch.

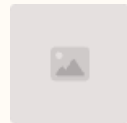

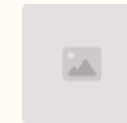
