Definisi dan Rumus

Future Perfect Continuous Tense menyatakan aksi yang akan sudah berlangsung untuk jangka waktu tertentu di masa depan.

Rumus (+)

S + will + have + been + V-ing

Contoh: I will have been studying for 3 hours by the time you arrive.

Rumus (-)

S + will + not + have + been + V-ing

Contoh: I will not have been working for 8 hours by the time the meeting ends.

Rumus (?)

Will + S + have + been + V-ing?

Contoh: Will you have been waiting for two hours by 5 PM?



Penggunaan Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Tense ini digunakan dalam berbagai situasi. Mari kita lihat beberapa contoh.

1 Durasi Aksi

By 10 PM, she will have been reading for 2 hours.

2 Sebab Akibat

He will have been feeling tired because he will have been working all day.

3 Aktivitas Berkelanjutan

When she arrives, they will have been playing soccer for 3 hours.

4 Menunjukkan Proses

By next month, I will have been practicing yoga for a year.

Kata Keterangan Waktu

Kata keterangan waktu membantu menentukan jangka waktu aksi yang telah berlangsung.

By this time

By this time tomorrow, next week, next year.

For + durasi waktu

For 3 hours, for a year, for a decade.

When + clause

When she arrives, when the meeting ends, when the project is finished.
